TERMS OF SALE

(Please Read Carefully)

1. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalog. The right is reserved to withdraw any lot prior to sale, or to group two or more lots.
2. All lots are sold without reserve to the highest bidder at a slight advance over the second highest bid. "Buy" bids are respectfully declined. In case of tie, the first bid received will secure the lot.
3. Successful bidders known to us, and those supplying acceptable references **WELL IN ADVANCE** of the closing date will have their lots forwarded for payment. All others will be notified and billed, and lots will be sent upon receipt of payment in full. Title shall remain with the CZSG sale committee until lots are paid for in full.
4. Bids will be executed according to prices and instructions on the bid sheet, at no charge to the bidder. Successful bidders will be subject to mailing expenses by insured or registered mail, with a minimum of 25¢.
5. Each lot has been examined by a competent authority, and is sold as genuine. If, however, in the opinion of a mutually acceptable authority, the lot is declared otherwise, the purchase price will be refunded in full, provided that notification is received by the CZSG sale committee within 30 days of the closing date of the sale.
6. Claims for errors in description must be made within 5 days of receipt of lots. Any lot for which the description is incorrect must be returned intact in the condition received. Exceptions: lots containing more than 10 stamps; stamps described with defects or faults; stamps with tropical gum (TG); or lots described AS IS, none of which are returnable.
7. Lots, we regret, cannot be mailed out for examination prior to the sale.

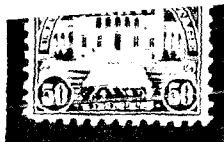

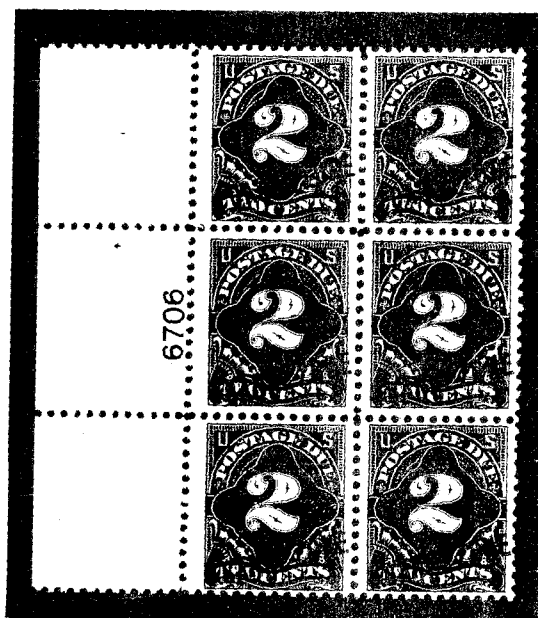

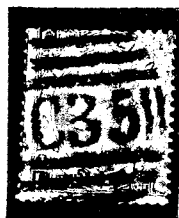

The total amount realized is \$9,595.75 and if the highest figures in the bid book had been used the total would be \$11,959.30 -- a difference of \$2,363.55 in favor of the bidders.
