\* The Board of Directors determined that each of these awards should consist of a medal. Pressed Metal Products in Vancouver, BC was commissioned to prepare a die using the design of the Canal Zone Study Group seal, member Dave King helped with the design and coordination with Pressed Metal Products.

The silver medals recognize **Exceptional Exhibits** of Canal Zone material. These medals were struck in fine silver and were 52mm in diameter. Those presented as the **Service Award** were overlaid in gold and engraved on the reverse and were accompanied by a certificate identifying the Award and naming the recipient. For the Exhibitor's Award, the medal in silver is presented, then subsequently engraved and a certificate prepared with the awardee's name.
